

CURRICULUM

Eugenio Canone is Research Director at the Italian National Research Council (CNR) and carries out his research activities at the Istituto per il Lessico Intellettuale Europeo e Storia delle Idee (ILIESI, Rome). His main fields of research are the history of Renaissance and early modern philosophy, the history of cultural terminology and philosophical lexicography. His research has focused particularly on the works of Giordano Bruno. He has edited texts and published various volumes, including unpublished material, on the works and the reception of Bruno, as well as studies on modern philosophy. Apart from many articles, he has authored two books specifically on Bruno: *Il dorso e il grembo dell'eterno. Percorsi della filosofia di G. Bruno* (2003) and *Magia de contrari. Cinque studi sulla filosofia di G. Bruno* (2005). Always on the Nolan philosopher he published a collection of texts and documents in 1992; a volume on Bruno's reception in 19th century Europe (1998); a commented edition of *Spaccio de la bestia trionfante* (2000); most of the texts included in a volume published as part of the series «Biblioteca di Bibliografia Italiana» commemorating the fourth centenary of Bruno's death in 2000; the edition of *Articuli adversus Peripateticos* in 2007; a commented edition of *Eroici furori* in 2011. In 1999, he edited the reprints of the original editions of the Italian works and the Latin philosophical poems of the philosopher. Canone has carried out research in Italy and abroad and has participated in many national and international conferences. He has lectured in various universities and cultural institutes. He has also been part of various university research projects. Canone directs a research project focusing on the study of philosophical lexicography in the modern period, covering in particular the 16th and 17th centuries. Within the context of this project, he has published many contributions and, in recent years, he has set up and directs ILIESI's digital archive «Lessici filosofici dell'età moderna». In 1995, E. Canone co-founded and currently directs, with G. Ernst, the International Journal of Philosophy «Bruniana & Campanelliana. Ricerche filosofiche e materiali storico-testuali» (listed in ISI - Thomson Reuters, and ANVUR: A), and the series «Supplementi di Bruniana & Campanelliana». Canone has organized international conferences and symposia on Renaissance philosophy and, more generally, on the history of philosophy. Between 1996 and 2000, he directed the project «Lecture Bruniane del Lessico Intellettuale Europeo», which included five conferences. In 2001, he established, and still directs, together with G. Ernst, the annual seminar «Per una Enciclopedia Bruniana e Campanelliana». Furthermore, Canone directs the series «*Novae insulae* - testi e storie di filosofia» (Ed. Agorà & Co.). He has set up and directs ILIESI's project «Archivio dei filosofi del Rinascimento» (digital archive). As from January 2010, he directs Research Unit (Commessa CNR IC.P01.009): «Storia del pensiero filosofico-scientifico e della terminologia di cultura dal Medioevo all'età moderna». He is also director of the ILIESI research unit of the PRIN (Programmi di Ricerca Scientifica di Rilevante Interesse Nazionale): «Ethics and the mind/body problem. Historical problems and theoretical perspectives».
