Area of specialization: History of philosophy, history of philosophical and cultural
terminology, modern philosophy, history of theologico-political thought.

Her research is oriented toward the study of the history of modern philosophy, from
the Renaissance to the Enlightenment, with particular reference to the study of Spinoza
and the history of Spinozism. The major themes include: (1) philosophical and
theologico-political thought from the sixteenth to the twentieth centuries; (2) the
edition and translation of philosophical texts of authors from the sixteenth to the
twentieth centuries; (3) the fortunes of Spinoza's and Descartes's philosophy in
modern Europe; (4) the lexicon and doctrines of the passions in the modern age; (5)
Spinoza and radical Biblical exegesis between the seventeenth and the eighteenth
centuries.

She has published various essays in collections and international journals, has
coordinated the publication and translation of the philosophical works of several
authors, has organized seminars, workshops, and international congresses. In addition,
she directed research projects and collaborations, publishing programs, and scholarly
initiatives.
