She graduated in Philosophy at the University of Rome La Sapienza (1984).

Since 1986 she is a researcher at the Institute for the European Intellectual Lexicon and History of Ideas (ILIESI) of the National Research Council (CNR).

Since 2001, she is Senior Researcher at the same Institute.

Professor of the History of Philosophy in the Department of Philosophy of the Sapienza University of Rome in 2012-2013.

She has obtained the national scientific qualification to function as full Professor in Italian Universities, field MFil-06 (11-C5, History of Philosophy), MIUR, DD n. 222/2012.

Her research is oriented toward the study of the modern philosophy with particular reference to the study of the history of Cartesianism and Spinozism. The major themes include: 1) philosophical, scientific and theologico-political thought from the sixteenth to the nineteenth centuries; 2) the edition and translation of philosophical texts; 3) the fortunes of Spinoza's philosophy in Italy and modern Europe; 4) the doctrine of the passions in the seventeenth century; 5) the radical Biblical exegesis between the seventeenth and the eighteenth centuries; 6) the history of philosophical and cultural terminology.
